The amended complaint, filed in a district court in California, also names new plaintiffs — Neuralink executive and ex-OpenAI board member Shivon Zilis and Musk's AI company, xAI.

Contradicting the Chief Minister's statement of seizing property of the culprits in the cash-for-job racket, Monserrate also said the government is not a recovery agent to seize the property of the accused and pay those who tried to buy the job.

"Instead, the government should order an inquiry under a retired judge to ensure transparency in the investigation," he noted.

However, the man insisted on an abortion. She alleged that the man made a farce of the marriage and repeatedly raped and physically assaulted her. The court noted that the woman gave birth to a baby boy, and as per the DNA analysis, the accused and she were the

It referenced a meeting held on October 3, 2024, promising to submit a detailed reply within four weeks. The tribunal's concerns are particularly relevant given the recent enactment of the Forest (Conservation) Amendment Act, 2023. There are fears that unclassed forests, which previously enjoyed protection under the landmark TN Godav-Thirumalpad case (2016), might become vulnerable to diversion without proper oversight

mechanisms in place. Of the 38 respondents served notices by the tribunal, including various state authorities and the Forest Survey of India, only the Union territory of Ladakh and Andhra Pradesh have submitted their responses.

The NGT has directed all remaining respondents to file their replies within two months. The role of state expert committees is crucial as they are mandated to prepare comprehensive reports on unclassed forests, regardless of ownership or notification status. These committees ensure that all forest categories receive protection under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, maintaining essential environmental safeguards.

The tribunal has scheduled the next hearing for March 3, 2025, where it will assess the progress made by the seven states in establishing their expert committees and review the measures
