

India's U23 men's national team have been drawn in Group H of the AFC U23 Asian Cup 2026 Qualifiers, where they will face hosts Qatar, Bahrain and Brunei Darussalam. The draw, conducted on Thursday, May 29. at the AFC House in Kuala Lumpur, sets the stage for a competitive campaign, with all Group H fixtures scheduled to take place in Qatar from September 1 to 9, 2025.

In total, 44 teams have been split into 11 groups of four. Each group winner and the four best runners-up will advance to the final tournament, alongside hosts Saudi Arabia. The seventh edition of the continental competition will be played in January 2026.
