ORDER

WHEREAS, incidents involving loss of life and serious injuries have been reported in and around abandoned and disused quarry sites within North Goa District;

AND WHEREAS, such abandoned quarries, when left unfenced, unsecured and without adequate warning signage, pose a grave and continuing threat to human life, livestock and public safety, particularly during the monsoon season due to water accumulation, slippery terrain and reduced visibility;

AND WHEREAS, unrestricted public access to abandoned quarries constitutes a preventable disaster risk under the provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005;

AND WHEREAS, the District Disaster Management Authority is statutorily mandated to take preventive and mitigation measures to reduce disaster risks and safeguard life and property;

NOW, THEREFORE, 1, Ankit Yadav, IAS, Collector & District Magistrate and Chairperson, District Disaster Management Authority, North Goa District, in exercise of the powers conferred under Sections 26, 30 and 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, and in the interest of public safety, hereby issue the following Administrative Order, compliance of which shall be mandatory and strictly enforced:

DIRECTIONS-

1. Mandatory Safety Measures

All owners, occupiers, lessees, firms, companies or persons having ownership, possession or control over abandoned or non-operational quarries in North Goa District shall:

- Erect durable barbed-wire fencing or equivalent physical barriers along the entire boundary/periphery of the quarry to prevent unauthorised entry;
- Install conspicuous, weather-resistant warning signages at all access points and at regular intervals along the boundary, clearly displaying warnings such as:
 - "DANGER-ABANDONED QUARRY"
 - "ENTRY PROHIBITED"
 - "RISK OF SERIOUS INJURY / DEATH"
- Ensure that the fencing and warning signages are maintained in good and effective condition at all times.

2. Time-Bound Compliance

The above safety measures shall be completed within thirty (30) days from the date of issuance of this Order.

3. Submission of Compliance Report

Every concerned owner/occupant/firm shall submit a Compliance Report to the office of the undersigned within the stipulated period, enclosing:

- Self-certification of compliance;
- Site photographs (before and after implementation);
- Location details of the quarry.

4. Verification and Inspection

- The Mamlatdar concerned, through the Talathi and other field staff, shall:
 - Serve this Order upon all concerned parties;
 - Conduct physical inspection of abandoned quarries within their jurisdiction;
 - Verify compliance and record findings with geo-tagged photographs.
- Each Mamlatdar shall submit a consolidated compliance and inspection report to this office within forty-five (45) days from the date of this Order.

5. Enforcement and Penal Action

- Non-compliance, partial compliance or false reporting shall attract penal action under Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, including fine and/or imprisonment, as applicable.
- In cases of default, the District Administration shall be at liberty to: Execute the required safety measures departmentally; and Recover the cost as arrears of land revenue from the defaulting owner/occupant, without further notice.
- Such non-compliance shall also be reported to the concerned departments for initiation of further action under applicable laws.

6. Responsibility of Field Functionaries

Any failure on the part of field officers to serve this Order, conduct inspections, or report non-compliance shall be viewed seriously and may invite administrative action.
